I am writing to give the IPC advance warning of points that the applicant, Covanta Brig y Cwm Limited, would like to raise with the Examining Authority at the Preliminary Meeting on Tuesday 7 June 2011.

Changes to cut and fill

Following our correspondence regarding the construction of the proposed facility and the environmental benefits that could be secured by retaining spoil on site and thereby raising ground levels, Covanta wishes to confirm with the Examining Authority the approach that should be taken to this amendment to the submitted details.

ES Addendum

Since the date of the application, the position in relation to some of the offsite development related to the DCO application have changed. In order that the Examining Authority has all the environmental information (including the public and statutory consultees' comments) regarding the proposed development available to it at the time it makes its decision, Covanta is preparing an addendum to the Environmental Statement. We would like to raise the question of how that additional environmental information should be advertised to ensure compliance with the relevant legislative requirements.

Availability of written submissions

Covanta would also like to raise the issue of the timing of written submissions being posted on the IPC's website. In particular, whether the IPC can ensure that written submissions are available to all parties within a certain period and whether any accommodation will be made to the examination timetable in the event that this is not done.

I should be grateful if these points could be passed on to the Examining Authority, and if further clarification is needed please do not hesitate to contact me.
