## Espoo - Wylfa Newydd Nuclear Generating Station - transboundary notification

The Norwegian Environment Agency acknowledge receipt of the notification for Wylfa Newydd nuclear generation station.

The Norwegian Radiation Protection Authority (NRPA) consider it important to receive information about proposed NPPs in the geographical proximity of Norway, and to have the opportunity to participate in the EIA process in accordance with the Espoo Convention. Norway therefore wishes to participate in the EIA procedure for the proposed NPP at Wylfa.

Both experience and impact assessments confirm that a NPP in operation represents a risk of transboundary radioactive contamination in neighboring countries, in the case of a major accident or incident. Participation in the EIA process could provide valuable information about the proposed NPP and an opportunity to assess the different scenarios that are investigated in connection with adverse transboundary effects from the NPP.
