Summary

The Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR) written representation to the Planning Inspectorate in respect of the proposed Wylfa Newydd nuclear power station provides the Inspectorate with the following:

1. Background information on the licensing regime and ONR's assessment process, including a description of the GDA process and ONR's assessment of Horizon Nuclear Power's suitability to hold a nuclear site licence. ONR's regulation of the site during the construction phase is briefly described.
2. ONR's work assessing site suitability, with reference to Government siting policy is described and a submission made concerning the removal of certain temporary structures prior to power station commencing operations.
3. A brief summary of the progress of the assessment of Horizon's nuclear site licence application.
