On behalf of Bryngwran Community Council,

Our representation is based on concerns about the possible effects of the Wylfa development:

1. Possible effects of increased Traffic flow through the village of Bryngwran related to the Dalar park and ride proposal. The effect this may have on the village, the safe route to school, air pollution, noise pollution are a concern to the community council.
2. Possible effects on house prices/availability of rented housing due to influx of Wylfa construction workforce. The local people in the village are finding it difficult to buy properties in the village due to their expense and there are more holiday homes appearing. How will Horizon manage their workforce accommodation to ensure that local people aren't made homeless by landlords who wish to house contractors and construction workers.
3. Possible negative effects on the Welsh Language both in the short and longer term on the village of Bryngwran and Anglesey generally due to influx of large numbers of non-Welsh speaking workers during and after construction phase (e.g possible effects on local Anglesey council are already naming a number of schools for closure and the effect this will have on our Welsh speaking communities could be detrimental. How will Horizon manage the contract companies to ensure they have an awareness and understanding of the Welsh language.
4. Health and Safety – with increased population in the local area how will Horizon make sure that the police, ambulance and fire services have enough resources to deal with events? If an accident happened on the A55 most traffic would be diverted through Bryngwran on the A5 towards the Park and Ride, how will Horizon manage and mitigate any risks, noise and pollution if this happened? During and after construction of the Dalar Hir Park and Ride
5. How will the working hours and the shifts be managed to ensure there is no extra traffic on the roads during the school run hours in the villages around Dalar Hir Park and Ride, there is one secondary school in Bodedern and 4 primary schools.
6. Small businesses in the area who employ local people will experience staff displacement. Which measures will Horizon be taking to reduce this risk?
