NRW wishes to attend the Accompanied Site Inspection on Wednesday 13 February and/or Thursday 14 February.

NRW advise that the Accompanied Site Inspection attends the following locations:

- Cemlyn Bay – in order to identify the special features of Cemlyn Bay Special Area of Conservation (lagoon and shingle ridge) and the Anglesey Terns Special Protection Area (location of the tern colony)
- Porth y Pistyll – in order to identify the marine works in the context of the existing environment
- Cooling Water outfall location – in order to identify the marine works proposed and the location of marine discharges during operation
- Tre'r Gof Site of Special Scientific Interest – in order to identify the special interest of the SSSI.
