Please note that the correct reference to the NACP representation is REP2-337 rather than REP2-333.

The potential to use the Madyn Farm site for Temporary Worker Accommodation was made by Horizon in their Stage 2 consultation documents. Full details are provided in Chapter 17 of the Stage 2 Main Consultation Document.

The NACP understand from this information that the proposal was for 200 bedspaces in 50 houses. However it is important to note that this is not a scheme for which the NACP hold any responsibility. The scheme was referred to in REP2-337 in the context of the other TWA sites that were being promoted by Horizon in the consultation stage. The NACP then also referred to the scheme in REP4-054, following Horizon's response to REP2-337 (Horizon document REP3-032). This response from Horizon stated that they were reconsidering the Madyn Farm scheme and NACP's REP4-054 confirmed our support for this action.
