I have been made aware that the DCO submitted by Horizon included a 'Statement of Common Ground' between Horizon and National Grid (doc. EN010007-003088-18) which refers clearly to a 400kv overhead line. However, the North Wales Connection Project was cancelled by NG, as confirmed by the Planning Inspectorate on the 20th February 2019. In essence, some of the above document is no longer valid, for example, Section 1.2.3. 'NG is promoting a second 400kv connection between the Wylfa and Pentir substations'. There are numerous other examples.

I feel it would be wrong for any DCO for Wylfa B to include references to overhead lines. power transmission needs to be a separate submission, as previous. There is not a single valid reason for transmission to be by overhead lines.

NG and Horizon need to revise all their documents to reflect the cancellation of the NW Connection project and resubmit them to the PI before this DCO application is finally decided.
