1 Introduction

1.1 Status of this document

- 1.1.1 This document is provided on the request of the Examining Authority (ExA) to assist in understanding areas of commonality across the Statements of Common Ground (SoCGs).
- 1.1.2 It comprises Horizon's understanding of the stakeholders' positions, as set out in the final SoCGs submitted by Horizon at Deadline 6 and Deadline 8 and is necessarily high level.
- 1.1.3 For a more detailed understanding of the respective stakeholders' positions in relation to the topics covered, reference should be made to the final SoCGs submitted at Deadline 6 and Deadline 8.
- 1.1.4 Horizon agreed with some interested parties to submit updated SoCGs at Deadline 8, to reflect ongoing positive discussions. Updated SoCGs are therefore being submitted at Deadline 8 for the following organisations and this Statement of Commonality has been updated to reflect the changes in position:
 - IACC
 - Welsh Government
 - NRW
 - North Wales Police

1.2 Background

- 1.2.1 Horizon is applying to the Secretary of State for a Development Consent Order (DCO) under the Planning Act 2008, to construct, operate and maintain a new nuclear power station on land west of Cemaes on Anglesey ("the DCO application").
- 1.2.2 The Wylfa Newydd Power Station will generate a nominal gross electrical capacity of 3,000MW of electricity, providing enough secure, low carbon power for around five million homes, and involve substantial investment in north Wales and create significant employment opportunities.
- 1.2.3 A description of the Wylfa Newydd DCO Project is provided within the Planning Statement (APP-406).

1.3 Purpose of this Document

- 1.3.1 Horizon submitted a Statement of Common Ground Position Statement with the DCO application which set out the way in which Horizon has carried out its consultation in order to facilitate the production of SoCGs and provided an update on progress made with each party at the time of the DCO application.

1.3.2 The Rule 6 letter issued by the ExA requested that a Statement of Commonality be submitted at Deadline 2. Through considering the Example Documents on the National Infrastructure Planning website¹, this is taken to mean a table which shows the commonality on specific points between SoCGs. Horizon has also taken the opportunity to use this document to provide an update on progress with each of the SoCGs that it has prepared with interested parties.

1.3.3 This document reflects the updated position in relation to common ground at Deadline 8 following further discussions with interested parties.

1.3.4 It should be noted that, as final SoCGs have been requested by the ExA prior to the end of the examination, there are ongoing matters within some of the SoCGs which have not been possible to resolve prior to parties seeing final documents to be submitted at later deadlines. This particularly applies to the draft S106 agreement and updated control documents, including the Wylfa Newydd Code of Construction Practice. Whilst drafts of these updated documents were provided in advance of Deadline 5, some parties have not been able to review them in sufficient detail to enable the SoCG to be updated. This is referred to in the SoCGs where relevant.

1.4 Structure of this Document

1.4.1 This document sets out the position of the final SoCGs as at Deadline 6 and is structured as follows:

- Section 2 details the structure of each SoCG document and provides an up to date list of SoCGs.
- Section 3 sets out the status of each SoCG.
- Section 4 sets out the commonality between SoCGs.

2 Structure of SoCGs

2.1 Structure of SoCGs

2.1.1 To ensure consistency in the approach taken to documenting matters agreed, matters subject to ongoing discussions or matters not agreed, the SoCGs generally adopted a standard format in order to provide clarity to other parties and ultimately the ExA.

2.1.2 The following SoCGs do not follow this standard format, either because they relate to limited topics, or because the SoCG party wished to follow a different format:

- NWEAB – which was submitted with the DCO;
- SP Manweb – which was submitted to the ExA with Horizon's response to the Rule 6 letter;
- Welsh Government – requested a different format;
- Conwy County Council – considers relatively limited issues.

2.1.3 Each SoCG is broadly structured as follows:

- A brief introduction and explanation of the purpose of the document;
- Where relevant, a description of the role of the SoCG party in the DCO process;
- A brief description of the development;
- A summary of consultation with the SoCG party;
- A description of project vision and objectives, including an agreed joint vision where applicable;
- A table setting out the current position by topic with colour coding to represent areas of agreement, disagreement and ongoing matters – for most SoCGs, this is set out by topic with areas of agreement, disagreement and ongoing matters stated under each topic.

2.2 Progress of SoCG

2.2.1 Table 2-1 sets out the current position in relation to each SoCG as at Deadline 8.

2.2.2 In addition to those parties that Horizon confirmed it would be entering into an SoCG with, the ExA asked Horizon to explore submission of a SoCG with organisations that represent the Welsh Language and have submitted a Relevant Representation.

2.2.3 Horizon indicated in its response to the Rule 6 letter that it would also be contacting the following parties with an aim of having a draft SoCG that can be submitted at Deadline 5:

- Urdd Gobaith Cymru (The Welsh League of Hope);

- Mudiad Meithrin (Welsh Early Years specialists);
- Menter Iaith Môn; and
- Clybiau Ffermwyr Ifanc Ynys Mon (Anglesey Young Farmers Club).

2.2.4 As requested by the ExA, Horizon sought IACC and Gwynedd County Council's views on the Welsh language organisations that it should be engaging with. As a result of that engagement, it was decided to instead contact Anglesey's Language Forum (Fforwm Iaith Mon) which is an umbrella organisation of which all of the above organisations are members, to explore entering into an SoCG with it. There are no organisations representing Welsh language in Gwynedd who submitted a relevant representation, however, it was decided that the views of any appropriate organisations within Gwynedd would be reflected within Gwynedd County Council's SoCG.

3 Status of SoCGs

3.1 Summary of current position

- 3.1.1 This section provides the position of each SoCG at Deadline 8.
- 3.1.2 Table 3-1 provides a high-level position and where necessary includes further detail to aid understanding of the ExA.
- 3.1.3 In summary, the high-level positions used in Table 3-1 are as follows:
 - Final SoCG with all matters agreed – The final SoCG demonstrates that all matters are agreed between both parties.
 - Final SoCG with some matters agreed and some not agreed – While some matters are agreed, it was not possible to reach full agreement on all matters. Each SoCG sets out how Horizon has engaged with the other party to seek agreement.
 - SoCG in final draft – The SoCG was drafted by Horizon, it has been shared with the other party and comments have been provided, but it has not been possible to reach full agreement with the other party that the document is a mutually agreed draft. For those SoCGs which are not agreed drafts, each SoCG sets out how Horizon has engaged with the other party to seek agreement. These drafts are considered by Horizon to be an accurate representation of the views of the SoCG parties.

4 Commonality

4.1 Summary

4.1.1 This section of the report provides a summary of principal issues covered in the SoCGs and demonstrates where there is commonality in the topics or matters being discussed with the various parties at Deadline 8.

4.1.2 Tables 4-1 to 4-4 are presented in such a way to show topics covered within the various SoCGs and how these are relevant to each party and a position for each topic as follows:

4.1.3 Where the matter is not relevant to a particular SoCG party, the column is left as blank.

4.1.4 Tables 4-1 to 4-4 are necessarily high level and is structured by topic and therefore it does not reflect the nuances for each area as set out in the SoCG. The table is however broken down into baseline (Table 4-1), methodology (Table 4-2), assessment (Table 4-3) and mitigation (Table 4-4) for each party and topic, in order to provide a better position of the level of agreement around each of these areas.

4.1.5 It is recognised that this approach is only applicable to Environmental Impact Assessment and other assessment topics. On this basis, for other topics, the level of agreement is shown only in the final table (mitigation). For the avoidance of doubt this relates to the following topics: principle of development, site selection, design, draft DCO and planning obligations.

4.1.6 It should be noted that some topics are marked as disagreed, where there is only a single area of disagreement on that topic. For the detail, readers should refer to the SoCGs.

4.2 Conditionality of agreement

4.2.1 Where a matter is marked as agreed, this is often conditional on mitigation being secured either through requirements within the draft DCO or through planning obligations within the draft s.106 agreement. Where this is the case, this is set out in the SoCGs.
