**Wylfa Newydd DCO Project: Deadline 9 Matters**

1. This letter sets out Horizon Nuclear Power Wylfa Limited's ("Horizon") response to matters allocated to the Applicant for Deadline 9 as outlined in the Rule 8(3) and 13 – Variation to Timetable for the Examination letter published by the Examining Authority ("ExA") on 12 February 2018 ("Rule 8 letter").

**Matters contained within Horizon's Deadline 9 submission**

2. In accordance with the Rule 8 letter, Horizon is submitting the documents listed in Appendix 1 to the ExA for Deadline 9. Further comments in respect of these documents are set out below.
3. Horizon has reviewed the Deadline 8 submissions of Interested Parties and considers that all issues raised have either already been addressed in previous responses or are addressed in the documents being submitted at Deadline 9. As such, Horizon is not submitting any further responses to those submissions.

**Summary of documents Horizon is submitting at Deadline 9**

4. Below is a short summary of the documents that Horizon is submitting at Deadline 9 (as identified in Appendix 1):
  - a. *Responses to ExA's Request for Further Information:* Further to the publication of the ExA's Rule 17 – Request for Further Information on 3 April 2019, Horizon is submitting

a written response that addresses all questions posed by the ExA to 'the applicant' and marked as due at Deadline 9. Accompanying this, as requested by the ExA, is a track change version of the Funding Statement submitted at Deadline 8 (Revision 2.0 against Revision 1.0).

Horizon will submit responses to any questions posed by the ExA to 'the applicant' and marked as due at Deadline 10, at Deadline 10 (17 April 2019), as well as any responses Horizon considers appropriate to other interested parties' responses at Deadline 9.

- b. *Mitigation Route Map*: In accordance with the ExA's Action Items from the March Issue Specific Hearings ("ISHs"), Horizon is submitting an updated Mitigation Route Map ("MRM") at Deadline 9. This MRM supersedes the MRM (Rev 3.0) submitted at Deadline 6 [REP6-023]. The MRM has been updated to reflect changes that have been made to the mitigation measures proffered by Horizon in its DCO application and up to and including Deadline 6, and to incorporate all additional mitigation measures Horizon has agreed following Deadline 6.


As per the MRM submitted at Deadline 6, Horizon is submitting an excel and PDF version of the MRM. The excel version of the MRM can be filtered by control document, geographical area, topic and source assessment. For greater clarity, the MRM now also includes a separate section (tab in the excel version and table in the PDF version) which records the mitigation measures that are secured by the DCO s.106 agreement.

- c. *Final DCO s.106 agreement*: As indicated at Deadline 8, Horizon is submitting a final DCO s.106 agreement as agreed between the signatories to that agreement. Horizon will submit an executed version of this agreed DCO s.106 agreement at Deadline 10.
- d. *Horizon's response to the Report on the Implications for European Sites*: Further to the ExA's Report on the Implications for European Sites ("RIES Report") [PD-016] published on 27 March 2019, Horizon is submitting a response to the RIES Report. Horizon's response confirms that the RIES Report provides a comprehensive summary of the issues relevant to the Conservation of Habitats and Species Regulations 2017 and the evidence put forward by Horizon and the other interested parties in this respect.
- e. *Tern Compensation Proposal*: In addition to its response to the RIES Report, Horizon is also submitting at Deadline 9 a paper titled 'Tern Compensation Proposal' which has been prepared following detailed discussions with Natural Resources Wales. The Tern Compensation Proposal outlines Horizon's proposed strategy in the event that the Secretary of State determines that the Wylfa Newydd DCO Project risks an adverse effect on the integrity of the Morwenoliaid Ynys Môn/Anglesey Terns SPA, and is satisfied that there are no alternative solutions and that imperative reasons of overriding public interest have been demonstrated, such that compensation is required.
- f. *Code of Construction Practice and Code of Operational Practice Documents*: Horizon submitted updated Code of Construction Practice (CoCP) and Code of Operational Practice Documents (Rev 4.0) at Deadline 8 in accordance with the ExA's directions following the March ISHs. Since then, Horizon has made further changes to address matters raised by the Welsh Government in respect of transport measures in the Wylfa Newydd CoCP. At the same time, Horizon completed a further review of these

documents to ensure that all other amendments recently agreed to have been captured in these documents and that all referencing and cross-referencing is accurate. As a result of this review, updated documents (in clean copy and track change) are being submitted at Deadline 9. For completeness, the updated Main Power Station Site sub-CoCP and the Marine Works sub-CoCP include Horizon's proposed tern compensation strategy as set out in its Tern Compensation Proposal. As stated above, the tern compensation strategy is designed to only take effect if the Secretary of State determines that the Wylfa Newydd DCO Project risks an Adverse Effect on the Integrity of the Morwenholiaid Ynys Môn/Anglesey Terns Special Protection Area (SPA) and inserts into the Order the DCO requirement that requires the provision of tern compensation sites (as set out in the Tern Compensation Proposal).

- g. *Phasing Strategy:* Further to its Deadline 8 submission [REP8-069] Horizon has undertaken further stakeholder engagement with the [Welsh Government, IACC and NRW]. Following these discussions, amendments have been made to the Phasing Strategy which is being submitted at Deadline 9. These amendments relate to trigger thresholds in respect of Non-Home Based workers for the delivery of the phase of the Site Campus.
- h. *Written opinion of Michael Humphries QC regarding the imposition of a Grampian condition:* Horizon is submitting a written opinion by Mr Michael Humphries QC on matters relating to the imposition of a Grampian condition in relation to Temporary Workers' Accommodation. This responds to the opinion of Mr Fraser-Urquhart QC submitted by Land and Lakes at Deadline 8 [REP8-076].
