Re: - Statement of Common Ground between Horizon and National Grid

It has been brought to my attention that a number of elements of the above document are no longer true. In particular, I also note that the developer has received over 100 submissions requesting that the statement of Common Ground between Horizon and National Grid should **not** contain **any** reference to overhead transmissions lines.

It would be wholly inappropriate for any development consent order for the power station to include reference to overhead lines specifically, despite writing previously, this still has not been done. Revision of this document is needed to reflect National Grid's decision to cancel their connection project in its entirety.

I would strongly urge the Examining Body to ensure that National Grid and Horizon make appropriate revisions to this, and any other, documents, to remove all reference to overhead lines and to upload to your website.
