Item 36 . Welsh Planning Policy & Climate Emergency Declaration

Further to your letter dated October 23rd regarding the Planning Application for Wylfa Newydd I write on behalf of the Welsh Anti Nuclear Alliance (WANA) to respond to Item 36. of your letter.

WANA formally objected to the Application by Horizon Nuclear Power Ltd for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Wylfa Newydd Nuclear Power Station in November 2018. We subsequently attended the Issue Specific Hearing on the Application on January 11th 2019 and gave verbal evidence on the Item on Climate Change. At that Hearing we asked for reassurance that up- to- date data on sea level rise had been incorporated into the Application but were shocked to hear that 2009 data had been used to estimate the likely flood / sea level rise for the site. We subsequently followed up our concerns in writing more generally around climate change and Welsh Government legislation in January 2019 .

We believe current energy policy is out-of-date, fails to address climate change and is not appropriate for Wales as we have more than enough renewable energy sources of our own. We contend the proposals put forward by Horizon for Wylfa Newydd are totally inappropriate and should not be approved. I attach a summary of our concerns in relation to item 36 of your letter.
