Project Update (Horizon) Summary of key points Isle of Anglesey County Council (IACC) and Horizon discussed signing final Planning Performance Agreement (PPA) PPA and advice in October 2011. PPA covers Wylfa B New Nuclear Power given Station and associated development but not the National Grid electricity connection. IACC are considering preparing Position Statements (PSs) to support interim policy and planning guidance as the Local Development Plan (LDP) is not due to be submitted until 2016. Horizon to consult on nationally significant infrastructure project (NSIP) and enabling works/associated development concurrently making clear the distinction between the separate consenting regimes. A Statutory Working Group (SWOG) including IACC, Environment Agency Wales, Countryside Council for Wales, Cadw, Welsh Government Marine Consents Unit provides a high level overview and co-ordination of relevant development works and activities. **Anticipated Timescales (Horizon)** October 2011: IOCC deadline for comments on draft

December 2011: publish SoCC

- Q1/Q2 2013: stage 2 pre-application consultation (s42 and s47) (PAC2)

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Preliminary Environmental Information (PEI) (Horizon)

- The first PEI is an update on the Scoping Report and is not detailed.
- Further, more detailed, PEI at PAC2.
- Proposed work scope of Welsh Language Impact Assessment and Health Impact Assessment - to be appended to the PEI.

The Rochdale Envelope and Limits of Deviation (IPC)

• IPC advised that the Environmental Statement (ES) should assess the proposed development and where this was not yet clear, assess the worst case.

Transboundary Impacts (IPC)

• IPC advised developer to refer to IPC Advice Note 12 'Transboundary Impacts Consultation' and prepare a 'screening matrix' for transboundary consultation.

Other Matters (IPC)

- IPC advised that the developer may wish to consider the mechanism for discharge of requirements when preparing the draft Development Consent Order (DCO) – this may for example involve the application of the appeals procedure under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (TCPA 1990) by way of s120 of the Planning Act 2008
- An IPC outreach event would ideally be around 2 weeks prior to commencement of formal consultation and the IPC needs 2 months notice to prepare for an outreach event.
- The IPC is scheduled to give a presentation to IACC full Council in November 2011.

Specific decisions/ follow up required?

- **IPC:** update anticipated submission date on IPC website to Q3/Q4 2013.
- **Horizon:** notify IPC of dates for formal consultation to allow time to prepare for IPC outreach event.
