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Regarding this application in relation to The Sizewell C (Nuclear Generating Station) Order 2022 (SI 2022/853).

I wish to comment and object in the strongest possible terms as follows:

I believe what is proposed represents changes far too significant to be considered non material, and warrants the full public awareness and thoroughgoing scrutiny that this form of application avoids.

In particular, regarding Change 1 (use of part of LEEIE as an Integrated Reinforcement Yard instead of a caravan park) and Change 2 (prolonged use of rail facilities at the LEEIE, the applicant's statement in the public notice that there will be no new or different affects on local residents or businesses shows a shocking level of arrogance and contempt. This claim is entirely false.

The use of trains to the LEEIE for the duration of the project upto 2039 or thereabouts, instead of an initial period of two years or so as originally consented, represents a huge change to the situation residents will have to endure.

And and they can take no comfort from the DCO requirement that no trains should use the line through Leiston at night (between 11.00 pm and 7.00 am I understand); recently trains did in fact travel through several consecutive nights. So it is apparent assurances about this point and other matters cannot be relied upon.

The noise and disturbance that will be experienced as a result of the use of the bar cutting, bending and reinforcing cage assembly building, the shunting in and out of the building from open storage areas, opening and shutting of doors etc etc, all on a 24 hour a day's basis will be totally unacceptable.

Based on the figures quoted for Hinckley C , 230,000 tonnes of reinforcing steel will be needed for Sizewell C. And it proposed to deliver all this to and process it at the LEEIE not far from my home, and activity which will continue for many years.

I therefore object to these proposals, and to use of the non material application process.
