REGULATION 4 OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING (CHANGES TO, AND REVOCATION OF, DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDERS) REGULATIONS 2011 ("THE 2011 REGULATIONS")

APPLICATION TO MAKE A NON-MATERIAL CHANGE TO THE SIZEWELL C (NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION) ORDER 2022 (S.I. 2022/853)

Introduction and Background

Sizewell C Limited ("**SZC Ltd**") (company number 09284825) of registered address 25 Cophall Avenue, London, England, EC2R 7BP is the undertaker with the benefit of the Sizewell C (Nuclear Generating Station) Order 2022, which was granted by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (as they then were, now the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero) on 20 July 2022 (S.I. 2022 No. 853) (the "**Order**"). The application for the Order had reference EN010012.

The Order authorises the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of the Sizewell C nuclear power station, comprising two UK European Pressurised Reactor units located adjacent to the existing Sizewell B power station on the Suffolk coast, approximately 3 kilometres north-east of Leiston, together with the associated development and supporting infrastructure required for its delivery ("**Sizewell C**").

SZC Ltd is applying to the Secretary of State pursuant to section 153 and paragraph 2 of Schedule 6 to the Planning Act 2008 and Regulation 4 of the 2011 Regulations to make a non-material change to the Order ("**NMC1**").

NMC1 comprises a focussed package of eight changes and corrections to the Order and associated certified control documents. In summary, those changes relate to: use of part of the Land East of Eastlands Industrial Estate as an Integrated Reinforcement Yard; simultaneous use of rail facilities at the Land East of Eastlands Industrial Estate and Temporary Construction Area; greater flexibility in the siting of the Intermediate Level Waste Store; amendments to public rights of way associated with the Sizewell Link Road, Two Village Bypass and Main Development Site; clarification of the process for approving departures from certified control documents; refinement of the Traffic Regulation Order power; ensuring variations to the Deemed Marine Licence can take effect without a parallel change to the Order; and correction of minor drafting errors. Each change is explained in the enclosed Application Report.

The proposed changes are limited in scope. They do not extend the Order limits, do not require additional compulsory acquisition of land or rights and do not alter the fundamental nature of the authorised development. The Environmental Compliance Report accompanying the application

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confirms that, when considered individually and cumulatively, the proposed changes would not give rise to any new or materially different likely significant environmental effects beyond those reported in the Environmental Statement relied upon by the Secretary of State in making the Order, and would not alter the conclusions of the Habitats Regulations Assessment. No updated Environmental Statement or revised Habitats Regulations Assessment is therefore required.

On 23 April 2026, SZC Ltd sent a letter to the Secretary of State requesting consent to consult a targeted list of consultees pursuant to regulation 7(3) of the 2011 Regulations (the "**Request**"), with additional detail provided subsequently. SZC Ltd will consult the persons it has proposed to consult in its Request and once the Secretary of State has confirmed whether anyone else need be consulted, SZC Ltd will act accordingly and will provide the Secretary of State with a consultation and publicity statement pursuant to regulation 7A of the 2011 Regulations.
