Dear Dr. Roast,

The Marine Management Organisation (“MMO”) received a request on 10 March 2026 to vary the Deemed Marine Licence (“DML”) contained within Schedule 21 of the Sizewell C (Nuclear Generating Station) Order 2022. This request related to the amending of the wording within DML Condition 36(3) as follows:

Existing: Part 3 Paragraph 36(3)

“In the event that impact piling is required in the construction of Work No. 1A(l) and Work No. 1A(aa), the impact piling for the Work No. must not commence between May and August of any year...”

Proposed: Part 3 Paragraph 36(3)

“In the event that impact piling is required in the construction of Work No. 1A(l) and Work No. 1A(aa), the impact piling for the Work No. must not commence between May and August of any year, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the MMO,...”

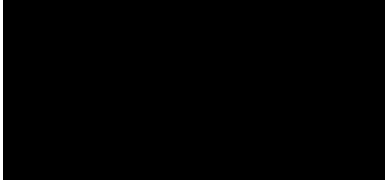
The MMO has now completed its consideration of this request and, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, has varied the DML as detailed in the Notice of Variation enclosed. Also enclosed is a copy of the varied DML.

(First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009 (SI 2009/1976) you have 28 days from the date of the sending of the notice of variation to send or deliver a notice of appeal to the First-tier Tribunal.
