**The Sizewell C Project, Application Ref. EN010012**

**Certification of Compliance with Section 56 and Section 59 of the Planning Act 2008 and Regulation 16 of The Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 (the Certificates)**

On 27 May 2020 NNB Generation Company (SZC) Limited (the **Applicant**) submitted an application for development consent for the Sizewell C Project to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (the **Application**). The Application was accepted by the Planning Inspectorate (on behalf of the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy) on 24 June 2020.

The proposed Sizewell C nuclear power station would comprise two UK EPR™ units with an expected net electrical output of approximately 1,670 megawatts ('MW') per unit, giving a total site capacity of approximately 3,340MW. Once operational, Sizewell C would be able to generate enough electricity to supply approximately six million homes in the UK. In addition, the Applicant has identified associated development sites which are required for the construction or operation of Sizewell C or to mitigate its impacts.

The Applicant encloses with this letter:

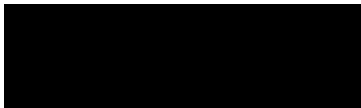
