Dear Sirs,

I am writing on behalf of Butley, Wantisden & Capel St Andrew Parish Council to urge the Planning Inspectorate to delay the start of the SZC DCO for the following reasons.

1. The extension of the SPR examination (EA1N and EA2) until 6 July. The cumulative effect of both these examinations will have a major impact on anyone taking part in both - which applies to many individuals, Town and Parish Councils, as well as the District and County Council. Even if hearings do not clash, there is a great deal of material on both applications to be assessed, and the burden will further disadvantage Interested Parties.
2. PINS will not decide whether to accept EDF's new proposals until the examination is due to have started. Every single day lost will disadvantage those with limited resources. We urge PINS to delay the start of the examination until after this decision is taken.
3. The pre-election period for Suffolk County Council's elections begins on 14 April. Even after the elections, there is a delay until cabinet appointments are made, meaning there will be no Suffolk County Council Sizewell C lead in place until the end of May.

I trust that you will take these comments into consideration.
