Timing of the examination:

Please delay the start of the examination until you have decided whether or not to accept the application. Otherwise the effective time of the Examination will be shortened, and this will inevitably disadvantage groups with limited resources.

EDF'S new proposals:

Can the entire submission be integrated into a single submission? It is not reasonable to expect that members of the general public will be able to read and integrate for themselves two complicated sets of proposals

Principal Issues .:

The issue of coastal defences should be considered in public, including residents. If problems arise with the coastal defences at any time in the future, local residents will be affected more than anyone else.

CO2 emissions should be considered over the lifetime of the project, including decommission.

Finance:

There should be a time for the independent examination of recently produced financial reports.

Policy and need:

The consideration of alternative sites

Marine ecology:

The possible removal of the Acoustic Fish Deterrent (AFD) from the proposal should be discussed in public, with consideration of the estimates of any such removal on local fish and eel populations.

Air quality:

Impacts of borrow pits and spoil heaps on those living closest to the proposed development (eg those living at Eastbridge) must be made explicit.
