## **Planning Inspectorate Sizewell C Project**

### **Request for Site Visit Locations in Pettistree**

1. Pettistree Parish Council endorses the Site Visit Locations proposed by Wickham Market Parish Council. Wickham Market provides many of the facilities of everyday living upon which we rely and require easy access.
2. Throughout the consultation process, Pettistree Parish Council has expressed its concerns about the threat to our village and its lanes from heavy traffic using our single track lanes as a "Rat Run" in order to access the A12 and avoid the predicted congestion in and around Wickham Market on the B1078 and the B1438. No effective solution has been proposed.
3. The locations suggested are:-
  - a) The Village Green in Pettistree. This is where Thong Hall Road, The Street, Presmere Road and Grove Road all meet at The Green. All these 'roads' are lanes and the verges and corners will become damaged or blocked by Rat Run traffic including both Sizewell C traffic and non-Sizewell traffic that is also avoiding the congestion.
  - b) The junction of Walnuts Lane and The Street at the Greyhound Inn. The road here is often restricted by cars parked by people attending this popular pub and/or the Church. Extra traffic will worsen damage that already occurs to the verges and corners here and puts the adjacent listed buildings at risk.
  - c) The junction of The Street with the B1438 at the site of the "The 3 Tuns" public house. This is where traffic will enter and exit the Rat-Run" system that we fear will develop as traffic uses the A12 to bypass the Wickham Market congestion towards the Souther Park and Ride.

I am not certain that the visits need to be accompanied but members of Pettistree Parish Council would be pleased to attend if it will be helpful.
