We wish to add our voice to the many objecting to this ill-conceived project.

Apart from the desecration of a priceless environmental asset along this beautiful, but is some cases eroding, coastline that is valued by the many visitors and nature lovers each year, the technology is unproven (see other current faltering projects that are running into problems) and the carbon pay-back too far into the future to help achieve the Government's target of CO2 reduction by 2035. There is also the worrying issue of nuclear waste for which there is no long term solution.

There is a high risk that this project will not prove financially viable even assuming the money is found to pay for its construction which at the present time must be in doubt.

Of major concern is that the infrastructure to support the projected numbers of workers and volume of vehicular traffic, much of it being HGV's and the like, is wholly inadequate and will make life intolerable for those living and working in the area, and having a detrimental effect on the local economy.
