I am opposed to the construction of Sizewell C for the following reasons.

- 1. The project is both expensive and uncertain. There are no 3<sup>rd</sup> generation reactors at work in Europe even though the plant in Finland has been under construction for over 15 Years.
- 2. The price of electricity generated at Sizewell will be excessive in comparison to wind, solar or very much smaller nuclear facilities.
- 3. East Anglia is short of water at present and will be even further limited if potable water is diverted to Sizewell. A desalination plant for the provision of water for construction is expensive, polluting (transport of diesel and removal of salt) and difficult to reinstate (the site) at the end of its life.
- 4. Sea rise is likely to make the site an island which will have to be protected for over 250? Years.
- 5. The impacts on Minsmere nature reserve are at best unknown but likely to be catastrophic. This is one of the most precious bird reserves in the country.
