Dear Sirs

I object to the Atlantic Array proposal on the following grounds:

- The proposed wind farms are inappropriately close to sites of scientific interest and designated protected areas.
- The wind farms will have a harmful effect on marine wildlife.
- Numerous safety issues for large ships and small craft have been identified.
- Tidal power should be considered as an alternative, being far less destructive and having less adverse impact on local economies.
- There is no reliable data on the erratic nature of wind power, therefore any cost analysis is unreliable.
- The Atlantic Array proposal clearly does not represent value for money since, at best, it will contribute only a tiny percentage towards renewable energy targets. Inevitably the taxpayer will foot the bill for this folly.
