The Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 (S.I. 2015/318) (as amended) (the "DCO")

Consultation and Publicity Statement under Regulation 7A of the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011 ("the 2011 Regulations")

Doggerbank Offshore Wind Farm Project 1 Projec Limited ("Projec 1") and Doggerbank Offshore Wind Farm Project 2 Projec Limited ("Projec 2") (together "the Applicants") which benefit from the DCO (herein "the Project"), have applied to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero for consent to make a nonmaterial change (NMC) to the DCO (as amended) under section 153 and Schedule 6 of the Planning Act 2008.
