I am writing further to our letter dated today notifying E.ON of the decision to accept the Rampion Offshore Wind Farm application for examination. The purpose of this letter is to provide advice under s51 of the Planning Act 2008 as amended (PA 2008).

The Planning Inspectorate has provided advice to E.ON about the application for Rampion Offshore Wind Farm, most notably at our meeting on 15 January 2013 and during the acceptance period for the previous application for the project which was withdrawn on 2 January 2013.
