**THE EAST ANGLIA THREE OFFSHORE WIND FARM ORDER 2017 (AS AMENDED)
("THE ORDER")**

REQUEST FOR DISCHARGE OF REQUIREMENT 38 – CROMER PRIMARY SURVEILLANCE RADAR – DEFINED IN SCHEDULE 1, PART 3, OF THE ORDER

1. On 14 August 2025, ScottishPower Renewables, on behalf of East Anglia Three Limited ("the Applicant"), made a request to the Secretary of State for Energy Security & Net Zero ("the Secretary of State") to discharge Requirement 38 – Cromer Primary Surveillance Radar – under Part 3 of Schedule 1 to the Order¹.
2. As part of its request, the Applicant submitted a Primary Radar Mitigation Scheme, and an email of 20 August 2025 from the NATS (En Route) plc ("NATS") Safeguarding team.
3. In accordance with Requirement 38, the Secretary of State is required to consult with NATS before deciding whether to discharge the Requirement. The Secretary of State therefore invites any further comments from NATS.
