Re: East Anglia One North and East Anglia Two

I would like to respond and take issue with [National Grid's response to the Examining Authority's Written Questions](#) in which they have stated they will not attend Issue Specific Hearings 1 & 2 and have not fully answered the Examining Authority's Written Questions by using evasive and deflective answers.

I was one of the speakers at the first lot of hearings and made the point strongly that part of the chaos of Friston is that there is no coordination between SPR and National Grid. It also appears that the latter is not accountable to anyone and certainly not open to questions from the local citizens.

How can the Examining Authority hope to continue with a fair, open and thorough examination when a major player such as National Grid does not participate? We will continue to be kept in the dark about the full extent of the Examination with regard to additional connections to the grid at Friston.

Could the Examining Authorities please enlist the support of the Secretary of State to then insist / summon / subpoena / or by whatever means, to get National Grid Electricity Transmission (NGET) to:

1. attend the Issue Specific Hearings and
2. answer the Examining Authority's Written Questions in full, in particular questions 1.0.16 and 1.0.17 with reference to ALL six additional energy projects that have been put on the table

Confidence will be lost in the NSIP Examination process should PINS not bring National Grid to account on these and other outstanding questions.
