Response to Examining Authority's Rule 9 Letter

On 16 December 2019, the Marine Management Organisation (the "MMO") received notice under section 56 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "PA 2008") that the Planning Inspectorate ("PINS") had accepted an application made by Scottish Power Renewables Limited (the "Applicant") for determination of a development consent order for the construction, maintenance and operation of the proposed East Anglia Two Offshore Wind Farm (the "DCO Application") (MMO ref: DCO/2016/00005; PINS ref: EN010078).

The Applicant seeks authorisation for the construction, operation and maintenance of DCO Application, comprising of up to 75 wind turbine generators together with associated onshore and offshore infrastructure and all associated development ("the "Project").

The MMO received a Rule 9 letter on 21 May 2020. In response to this letter, the MMO submits the following:

1. Comments on Relevant Representations (RRs)

The MMO has reviewed the Relevant Representations of various advisors and currently has no comment to make. The MMO would like to review the responses to Relevant Representations made by the applicant, as well as further written representations from advisors, before providing comments.
