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Dear Sirs,

Together with Cllr Haworth-Culf, fellow Ward member for the affected area, at this stage in the examination process I would like to thank the Planning Inspectorate for continuing to encourage comments from those both nearly affected, and from the wider community with perhaps broader but equally valid concerns.

I wish to reiterate the strongest objection to the principal of siting the NGV and SPR structures and infrastructure at Friston, and the attendant works that would support them.

Should the Friston site be approved as an Energy Hub, as is indicated it will be if this application is approved, as currently planned it alone could be devastating for the local community and highly damaging for the entire area. The cumulative impact of currently the 8 foreseeable energy related projects requires robust assessment as a whole. This should be undertaken not only for the site at Friston, but the landfall site together with the cable corridor. Of course not all of the energy projects currently being either examined or proposed may proceed, however this does not mean that a full assessment of the cumulative impacts should not be undertaken now in relation to all foreseeable projects.

In summary, I would respectfully request that Scottish Power Renewables is required to undertake a full Cumulative Impact Assessment of all known projects; and that a rigorous examination of this Cumulative Impact Assessment is undertaken.
