Ref: Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm update

Dear ,

I am writing to give you an update on the Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm, an extension project of the existing Galloper Wind Farm in the southern North Sea. As you may recall RWE and partners signed an Agreement for Lease for the new offshore wind farm development with The Crown Estate last year.

The Five Estuaries project is still within the early phase of development and have accepted a revised connection offer from National Grid for a new substation expected to be located within the East Anglia Coastal area, the location of the substation is unknown. The exact location of the connection point is expected to be determined in 2022. By accepting this new connection offer it means that the Five Estuaries project will no longer be pursuing a connection at Friston, Suffolk.
