* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

The Application is for development consent under the Planning Act 2008 to construct and operate an offshore wind farm located more than 47 km from the coast of Norfolk (the Project). The Project comprises up to 200 wind turbine generators and associated onshore and offshore infrastructure. The offshore array site occupies an area of approximately 592 km2 over two distinct areas, Norfolk Vanguard East and Norfolk Vanguard West. The Project is described more fully in the Explanatory Memorandum (Document 3.2).

Under the Planning Act 2008 (the 2008 Act), all new offshore renewable energy generation developments over 100MW are Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIP). As the proposed wind farm is expected to have an export capacity of up to 1,800 MW, it qualifies as an NSIP pursuant to section 14(1)(a) and 15(3) of the 2008 Act. Therefore the Applicant is obliged to submit an application to the Secretary of State for development consent under section 37 of the 2008 Act.

5. Non-technical description of the Development Proposal



* Brief non-technical description of the development proposal

The development proposal comprises the construction and operation of up to 200 wind turbine generators (WTGs) with a maximum tip height of up to 350 metres, up to two meteorological masts, up to two accommodation platforms, up to two offshore electrical platforms, inter-array cables that collect and transfer power generated by the WTGs to the offshore substations, and export cables that take the electricity generated by the WTGs to shore.

The onshore electrical works consist of underground cables running from mean high water springs at Happisburgh South, Norfolk to a new onshore project substation located to the East of the National Grid substation at Necton in Norfolk and an underground connection between the two substations. Works are also required to the existing National Grid substation at Necton to extend the substation to accommodate the Norfolk Vanguard connection points and modify the overhead line structures adjacent to the substation. The onshore connection works also include the option to lay the cable ducts for a future project, Norfolk Boreas (also being developed by Vattenfall), from Happisburgh South, to the location of the future onshore substation for Norfolk Boreas at Necton.

A full description of the works can be found in Chapter 5 (Project Description) of the Environmental Statement (Document 6.1).

6. Location or Route of the Development Proposal

The proposed Project is situated off the coast of Norfolk, approximately 47 km from the shore at the nearest point. The offshore array site occupies an area of approximately 592 km2 over two distinct areas, Norfolk Vanguard East and Norfolk Vanguard West.

The buried export cable corridor would connect the offshore development to a landfall at Happisburgh South, Norfolk. The landfall will be achieved using Horizontal Directional Drilling techniques to install cable under the coastline and foreshore.

The buried onshore cable corridor would run between the landfall and the new onshore project substation at Necton in Norfolk. The route is approximately 60 km long in a predominantly westerly direction from the landfall, largely passing through agricultural land.

The new onshore project substation would occupy a site area of approximately 9.5 hectares (including a temporary construction compound for ancillary works such as earthworks, but excluding landscaping areas and access). The new onshore project substation is located to the East of the existing National Grid substation at Necton. There would be a need for additional underground cabling between the new onshore project substation and the existing
