We write further to the Planning Inspectorate's Rule 8 letter dated 19 December 2019 (the **Rule 8 letter**). In accordance with the deadlines at Annex A of the Rule 8 letter, we enclose the following in response to Deadline 3:

- 1. Post hearing submissions including written submissions of oral cases
- 2. Responses to further information requested by the Examining Authority
- 3. Applicant's comments on late submissions at Deadline 2.

The Applicant refers the Examining Authority (**ExA**) to the Guide to the Application (Document Reference 1.4 (Version 4)) for a full list of documents submitted by the Applicant as part of Deadline 3.

Action Points

Pursuant to point 16 of the Action Points from Issue Specific Hearing 1 - Onshore Environmental Matters published on 8 February 2019, the ExA requested the Applicant to submit the landscape character assessments as standalone documents (in substitution for web links). The Applicant has provided these figures as standalone documents with the exception of the Broadland District Council landscape and visual character assessment figure 2.2. This figure exceeded the Planning Inspectorate's maximum file size for electronic uploads. The Applicant has therefore provided a website link for this figure within the document and is also arranging for a USB device to be sent to the Planning Inspectorate which includes this figure.

The Applicant also notes that, at Issue Specific Hearing 1 into onshore environmental matters, the ExA requested that the Applicant:

1. Provides a smaller scale hard copy of the photomontages to aid the ExA for the purposes of the accompanied site inspection;

2. Clarifies how the correction to Figures 29.11a and 29.11b (plans depicted in planting removals) will be captured.

In relation to point 1, the Applicant is liaising with the Planning Inspectorate in order to arrange for the safe receipt of the photomontages.

With regards to point 2, the Applicant can confirm that the revised figures (29.11a, Revision 7 and 29.11b, Revision 9) were submitted at Deadline 1 (document reference: ExA; WQApp14.1; 10.D1.3) and are captured within the Guide to the Application (document reference 1.4).
