I live at with my partner . Our house is probably the closest to the crossing point in the field to the rear of our property. Beyond the crossing point, both sets of cables/working corridors will run extremely close to our home - in particular Vattenfall - before exiting across Cawston Road (Vattenfall) or to the Marriotts Way (Orsted) (please refer to attached map.)

I seek reassurance that our wellbeing will not be affected in *any way* due to the close proximity of the crossing point to our home especially as Vattenfall have committed to DC and Orsted AC. DC is so much better....we still hope Orsted end up going that way too.

I would also like to add that I agree 100% with comments made by Alison Shaw of Oulton Parish Council (open hearing Dereham 24 April 2019).

It may also be worth noting that the loss of farmland during and after development could have a severe effect on food/grain supply which will be exacerbated by Brexit – especially hearing the comments made last night from who farms at Necton quoting ""Cables were laid across six of our fields in 2016. Three years on and this land has still not been fully reinstated."

Finally, I am not objecting to the development of wind farms, I understand the need for alternatives to gas (Reepham has no laid gas), oil etc, and I appreciate there will have to be a certain amount of disruption for all of us, but it's a hard pill to swallow when there could have been and hopefully still can be, an alternative with an off-shore ring main.
