

Examining Authority's Note of Unaccompanied Site Inspections

Examining Inspectors Karen Ridge, Grahame Kean, Gavin Jones and Caroline Jones (the Panel appointed as the Examining Authority for the Norfolk Vanguard Offshore Wind Farm) undertook unaccompanied site inspections (USIs) as listed below.

The USIs were undertaken by car and on foot, on public roads and footpaths. Routes for visits were planned having regard to issues raised during the Examination, enabling the Panel to obtain views of the proposed landfall, onshore cable route, NG extension, proposed substation, proposed compounds and access routes. Regard was also given to the verified viewpoints contained in the Environmental Statement (ES).
