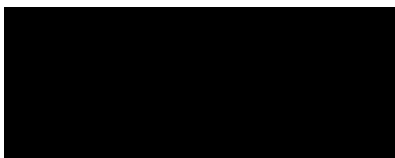
As set out in the Applicant's submission 'Annex 1: Consultation Report', on 24 October 2022, ESC confirmed to the Applicant that:
