Re: East Suffolk Council (ESC) response to EN010089 - Norfolk Boreas BEIS Consultation following the Applicant's submission of the Lesser Black-Backed Gull Implementation and Monitoring Plan and associated documents to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy for his consideration - (Wednesday 9 November – Thursday 24 November 2022).
