## Comments on Developer's proposed draft itinerary for the Accompanied Site Inspection

Anne Salmon BA MCD MRTPI has indicated that she intends to attend the ASI on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at 9.15am at Graveney Village Hall

<u>Table 1.1</u> The Faversham and Swale East Branch Labour Party has no objection to any of the sites within or adjacent to the development site proposed by the developer for inclusion in the ASI. It is agreed that providing coloured flags on site to identify the solar park area, electrical compound and the extent of the Arable Reversion Habitat Management Area and any other features that the developer wishes participants to note would be helpful.

Table 1.2 FSEBLP also agrees with the locations proposed to be visited in Table 1.2. It is noted that some of these sites will involve walking and that no other means of access is possible. Some of the sites have limited parking which would not accommodate 20 cars and some have no parking at all. No indication is given as to whether parking is available or not at site 9, Harty Church. It is not clear what participants are expected to do with their cars where there is no parking. This is why clarification is needed as to whether all participants will be transported in communal transport such as a minibus.

Other table(s) Table 2.2 provides the intended start location and time for the ASI. There is no Table 2.3 which the developer's itinerary says covers this information.

There is no table of sites already visited by the ExA (meant to be Table 2.2) Note 13 is therefore not clear regarding whether it is intended that the ASI will visit all sites listed in Table 1.2.
