Application by Norfolk Boreas Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Norfolk Boreas Offshore Wind Farm

Notification of a new deadline for completion of Examination; variation to the Examination Timetable and request for information

On 6 April 2020, the Planning Inspectorate asked the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy to consider requests from a number of Interested Parties to extend the Examination period for Norfolk Boreas Offshore Wind Farm. The main reasons were:

- Due to Government Guidelines in relation to Coronavirus, several hearings needed to be postponed, potentially resulting in Interested Parties not being given a fair opportunity to participate in the Examination; and
- A number of Interested Parties no longer had the capacity to participate in the Examination process as a result of COVID-19 resource prioritisation.

The Planning Inspectorate proposed an extension of no longer than five months to the Examination period if the Secretary of State was so minded.

Taking these reasons into account, and after careful consideration, on 11 May 2020 the Secretary of State agreed to the extension. The Examination period is now reset and will conclude on or before 12 October 2020. The Secretary of State's letter is published in the Examination Library [OD-012].

In order to limit the spread of Coronavirus, the Planning Inspectorate has published and keeps up to date guidance on how it is responding to Government guidance. In view of this, the ExA has adapted its approach to the remainder of the Examination. An updated Examination Timetable under Rule 8(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 is now appended to this letter at **Annex A**.

In addition to a further round of written questions, the revised timetable also includes a virtual Open Floor Hearing and a virtual Issue Specific Hearing. In order to facilitate these events, the ExA has divided the virtual hearings into sections. The Open Floor Hearing will take place over four days and focus on a specific geographical area each day. The Issue Specific Hearing will also take place over four days and focus on specific topics on each day. The ExA intends to publish agendas and joining instructions for the virtual hearings approximately two weeks in advance.

Virtual events are held using systems which enable people to participate from many remote locations such as their own homes or offices, by clicking on a link in an email invitation or dialling a phone number. Members of the public can observe by visiting a website or dialling a phone number. Virtual events enable the widest possible participation in an Examination, especially whilst social distancing and travel restrictions are in force. They are held on the same procedural and legal basis and are subject to the same provisions of the Planning Act 2008 as physical events.
