Morning, Kerry.

Thanks for your letter and follow up email.

Apologies for the additional request but having considered further here, we were hoping to maximise the flexibility in delivering this project by tweaking the scope of the proposed NMC so that the battery capacity could be any of the following (changes from original request email in track).

- *the consented output and duration (i.e., up to 150MW at four hours duration); or*
- *up to ~~6~~300 MW at ~~one~~ ~~two~~ hours ~~s~~ duration; or*
- *any output between 150MW and ~~6~~300MW at a duration that results in 600MWh of capacity (e.g., 200MW for three hours; ~~300~~300MW at 2 hours; or ~~24~~200MW for ~~one~~ ~~two~~ and a half hours).*

This does not affect the analysis in the original email given the MWh remains the same and noise needs to and will be dealt with on a site wide level.

Could you confirm if this is acceptable on the basis of the consultation approach you have outlined yesterday (i.e. including the additional parties)?

If so, then I can confirm that other than personal information, we are content with the documents being published.
