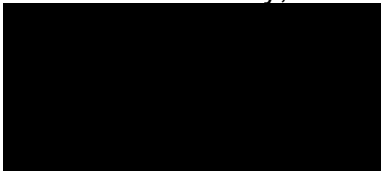
The MMO has reviewed the contents of your letter dated 05 May 2026 regarding the proposed updates to the GCIMP.

The MMO has reviewed the updates and note the target nest spaces have reduced from 7,806 to 4,827, which is a reduction from 164% to 101% of target new nest space due to a change in location for target nest spaces from L’Etac to sites on Alderney.

The MMO notes that although this provides a fine margin for target nest spaces, the MMO is satisfied with the proposed amendments and agree it is compliant with criteria in Schedule 16 Part 3 (Guillemot Compensation) of The Hornsea Four Offshore Wind Farm Order.

The MMO defers to Natural England as the Statutory Nature Conservation Body for ornithological impacts.
