I am responding to the letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> June concerning the arrangements for the Preliminary Meeting and Proposed Examination Timetable.

Having considered the proposed examination timetable I think that the deadline for Written Representations (WR) is too short a timeframe especially as this comes right in the middle of the holiday season.
