

Bidwells on behalf of the Mitcham family wish to object to the Sunnica DCO in its current form. As is standard practice with landed families, the Mitcham family own their landholdings in a number of different ownership structures. These different structures all have their own registration ID number. These are listed below.



Bidwells would be happy for the Examining Authority to combine these into one single registration ID number. At this stage, we will continue to submit for all parcels to ensure all are accurately represented, unless we are notified otherwise.

There are five areas of key concern which Bidwells wish to draw the Examining Authority's attention to.

â€¢ Representation 1 â€” scheme design

â€¢ Representation 2 â€” Area of rights acquired

â€¢ Representation 3 â€” Method of acquisition

â€¢ Representation 4 â€” Drainage

â€¢ Representation 5 â€” Ongoing and historic negotiations

These are all set out in full in the written representations.

At this point in time, there is a concern with these areas and we request either further details be provided by Sunnica to adequately address concerns, or if this is not forthcoming, that this should be treated as an objection to the scheme on all five grounds.

Bidwells reserves the right to provide further representations if Sunnica provide more appropriately detailed proposals for the sections impacting the Mitcham family landholdings.
