## **Further related submissions**

The Applicant acknowledges that Dr Edmund Fordham's submissions are substantial and detailed. Although a response has been provided by the Applicant at this deadline, the Applicant is aware that these matters will be discussed at the forthcoming hearings and will therefore expand its response as necessary at and/or after those hearings.

In relation to the post hearing submissions by Cambridgeshire County Council, East Cambridgeshire District Council, Suffolk County Council and West Suffolk Council, the Applicant has considered the issues raised at this deadline, particularly in the context of ongoing discussions regarding a side agreement that would address the Councils' concerns relating to design approval, inspection and maintenance procedures. Where acceptable to the Applicant, it will include amendments in the updated draft DCO submitted at Deadline 4. Where changes are not acceptable to the Applicant, it will explain why at Deadline 4.

The Applicant also intends to respond to the comments on the Joint Local Impact Report submitted by Natural England and Say No To Sunnica Action Group Ltd at Deadline 4.
