## **Deadline 7 Submission from Freckenham Parish Council**

At the ISH4 hearing on Thursday 16th February 2023 Sunnica downplayed the usage of Badlingham Lane (U6006), and suggested that around 5 people per day use this route.

This is incorrect.

As we have outlined in our written representation, Badlingham Lane is a popular and beautiful tranquil route, regularly used by walkers, dog walkers, cyclists, horse riders, etc. Freckenham Parish Council considers this an important asset from a recreation perspective and also from a heritage point of view. In addition, it is a valued wildlife spotting route where many species of birds, bats and other animals can be seen.

As you will have read in our written representation REP2-139, Freckenham Parish Council undertook its own survey of Badlingham lane and counted over 25 users in a single 2 hour period. This is a more typical representation of usage of this route.

Freckenham Parish Council agrees with the councils that fields E12 and E13 should not be developed.
