Dear Planning Inspectorate

Regarding the latest submission from Sunnica about changes that need to be made to their application, I would like to make the following comments:

1. I still struggle to understand why the project has been approved when your own examining authority has said that the risks and damage outweigh any benefits of the scheme.
2. There have been a number of submissions from Sunnica which amount to NMCs, (Non-Material changes) this goes to show the very poor planning and ineptitude of the company to get things right. And whilst this latest submission appears minimal on the surface and was necessitated by The National Grid, the paper work does show that even this will adversely affect wildlife, note the evidence of water Vole excreta. Once again Sunnica has no respect for local wildlife and eco-systems.
3. Most locals oppose the scheme and have tried their best to get views considered in what was a very poor, Sunnica-run consultation exercise. Many consequently attended the Examining Authority sessions and realised that actually Sunnica bluffed and blustered throughout the whole process and totally disregarded local objections at every turn. The outrage at the Secretary of State's dismissal of all the evidence is still felt acutely by all who submitted evidence that the examining authority agreed with.
4. It is now time to rescind this authority altogether and allow local wildlife to thrive, local water courses to remain clean and unpolluted, as well as farmland to continue to remain productive, and help meet the needs of the country, especially with our food security continually threatened by world events. It is all very well to have non-fossil fuel produced electricity, but if we cannot feed our population what will be the point.
5. While this may appear to be a very minor and non-material change to the application, it is a badly conceived application altogether and I repeat that the approval should be rescinded and this submission deemed to be not a NMC.
