I am writing to object to the Sunnica NMC request. Once again Sunnica are determining this plan on the hoof.

The idea that the DCO was approved when the fundamental grid connection plans were not determined, and agreed with all essential parties and stakeholders at the time of application is ludicrous.

It leaves residents and tax-payers in fear of the companies abilities. This is not the first request to make changes to the Grid-connection either.

The Planning Inspectors drew attention several times during the inquiry to Sunnica's lack of competence around detail and information and this is yet another sign. They are playing with peoples lives.

Furthermore the other NMC that has been withdrawn for now - for additional added value land - is more smoke and mirrors or as the County Council publicly identified a "Trojan Horse" for a yet undisclosed plan - what we have learned through experience that Sunnica is inconsistent.

I have no idea how the public are expected to have confidence in these schemes when the experience of the developer the SoS has entrusted is as flawed as this application itself. The Government's own Planning Inspectorate recommended this, and only this scheme, for refusal for very good reasons.

The SoS himself has been drawn into wording corrections to the original order (i.e. For "Construction and Traffic Management Plan," substitute "framework construction traffic management plan and travel plan"). Again, still loose, open to interpretation - a framework? as opposed to the 'firm plan' submitted.
