Good morning,

Please find representations on behalf of Isleham Parish Council.

Re: Representation from Isleham Parish Council to the application for a non-material change to The Sunnica Energy Farm Order 2024 (SI 2024/802) as corrected by The Sunnica Energy Farm (Correction) Order 2024 (SI 2024/1154) has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Energy and Net Zero by Sunnica Limited.

Isleham Parish Council objects to this latest change request. We spent considerable time responding to Sunnica's application and assessing its impacts on the basis of a defined project, with a defined boundary. Isleham Parish Council does not consider that the Order limits should be allowed to be extended post consent. This undermines the Development Consent Order process.

Sunnica Ltd has a track record in making changes to their grid connection proposals, which has created a deeply confusing picture and has made it very difficult for us and our parishioners to follow and assess the impacts of. The changes at the onset of examination involved significant changes to the grid connection including new infrastructure and further harmful impacts. Isleham Parish Council rejects further changes to the grid connection at this very late stage. We believe that this crucial part of the scheme should have been agreed from the beginning, not after the scheme boundary has already been approved.

It is clear that this is not a "shovel-ready" project.

Isleham Parish Council objects to the seemingly continuous changes and amendments to this already harmful scheme. It is unfair and could pave the way for yet more changes in the future, which undermines the NSIP process and provides yet more uncertainty for our parish.
