Objection to Sunnica Ltd Non-Material Change Request

Dear Planning Inspectorate,

I live in the area affected by the Sunnica Energy Farm and wish to register my strong objection to the latest non-material change request submitted by Sunnica Ltd.

This proposal continues a troubling pattern of Sunnica making significant changes long after consent was granted, while limiting the ability of local people to respond. Over 1,300 objections were submitted during the original consultation, demonstrating just how invested local communities are in this process. Yet with each new change request, it feels as though residents are being progressively shut out.

The grid connection and associated land take are fundamental parts of the project. They should have been fully resolved before the application was ever submitted. Instead, residents have faced repeated amendments, delayed timetables, and a constant drip-feeding of new information, often buried in technical documents that are difficult to interpret without specialist support.

Adding new land to the Order limits at this late stage is particularly concerning. It introduces new impacts and potentially affects people who may not even be aware that they are now involved, let alone able to participate meaningfully.

These cumulative changes create uncertainty, stress, and a sense that the safeguards of the Planning Act 2008 are being bypassed. I respectfully ask that this request be refused and that proper weight is given to the lived experience of the communities who continue to be affected by this proposal.
