The whole scope of the scheme is being changed as a result, which causes greater concern for the thousands of thoroughbred horses that live in and around Newmarket.

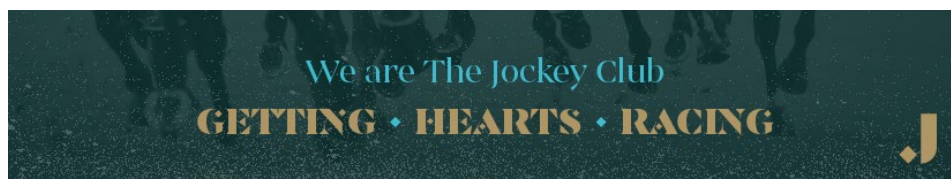
I request that you take our concern, which I am sure is reflective of the Newmarket racing community, into account before allowing any more changes to the Sunnica proposal.
