Dear Planning Inspectorate,

I wish to object to the latest non-material change request submitted on behalf of Sunnica Ltd.

The Sunnica Energy Farm has already been shown to cause substantial harm to the local landscape, heritage assets, wildlife, and rural economy. These impacts were clearly demonstrated during the Examination through over 1,300 objections and the resulting Examining Authority's recommendation that the scheme be refused.

Against that background, it is deeply concerning that Sunnica continues to bring forward further changes long after consent.

This latest request seeks to add land to the Order limits despite the fact that the grid connection remains uncertain and subject to delay. Connection dates have moved repeatedly and now extend to 2030, calling into question whether the scheme will deliver any meaningful contribution to national energy targets in the foreseeable future.

Allowing further amendments in these circumstances places continued strain on local communities who are already living with uncertainty, compulsory acquisition powers, and the prospect of long-term disruption. Limiting consultation on these changes only compounds that harm.

In my view, it would be entirely inappropriate to approve a non-material change linked to a grid connection that is not yet secured. I therefore respectfully request that this application be refused.
