Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm (AyM) will comprise an array of offshore Wind Turbine Generators (WTGs) in Welsh waters with an overall capacity greater than 350 Megawatts (MW), with supporting infrastructure to connect the array to the National Grid. AyM therefore constitutes a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) under Section 15(3B) of the Planning Act 2008.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development



* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

AyM is a proposed sister project to the operational Gwynt y Môr Offshore Wind Farm (GyM) off the north-east coast of Wales. AyM will comprise up to 50 WTGs and all associated infrastructure required to transmit the electricity generated to shore, at an onshore substation, and onward to the existing National Grid Bodelwyddan substation, as well as all infrastructure required to construct, operate and maintain the wind farm.

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development

The AyM array area lies approximately 10.5km off the north-east coast of Wales at Llandudno. The offshore Export Cable Corridor (ECC) extends from the south-western to south-eastern boundary of the array area in a south-easterly direction to meet land at Frith Beach between Rhyl and Prestatyn. The onshore ECC extends from the landfall to the onshore substation west of St Asaph's Business Park (SABP) before connecting to the National Grid substation at Bodelwyddan (south of SABP).
